On behalf of the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA), Center for Verification and Evaluation (CVE), I am writing to inform you that your application for reverification has been approved. American Architectural Metal Manufacturers, Inc. will remain eligible to participate in Veterans First Contracting Program opportunities with VA as a verified Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business (SDVOSB).

**This verification is valid for two years from the date of this letter.** Please retain a copy of this letter to confirm American Architectural Metal Manufacturers, Inc.'s continued program eligibility in accordance with 38 Code of Federal Regulation (CFR) § 74.12.

While CVE has confirmed that American Architectural Metal Manufacturers, Inc. is presently, as of the issuance of this notice, in compliance with the regulation, American Architectural Metal Manufacturers, Inc. must inform CVE of any changes or other circumstances that would adversely affect its eligibility. Eligibility changes not reported to CVE within 60 days could result in a referral to the Office of Inspector General (OIG), a referral to the Debarment and Suspension Committee, and the initiation of cancellation proceedings—all of which could result in American Architectural Metal Manufacturers, Inc. being removed from the VIP Verification Program.
